MISSION -

Ministering to broken lives and paving the way to knowledge of Jesus Christ

We pick up the broken pieces of the lives of wounded youngsters in group homes, shelters, detention centers, and orphanages by providing life-skills education and ministry through role model speakers, cultural experiences and one-on-one mentoring.

PURPOSE

To turn the tide of destructive behavior. We provide educational enrichment programs and materials, recreational activities, and introduce them to caring adults who encourage youth to overcome problems of drug and alcohol abuse, juvenile delinquency, teen pregnancy, the school dropout rate and suicide. We build self-esteem and character based on Christian principals thereby giving them hope and a chance to become productive citizens of tomorrow

WHO WE SERVE and WHAT WE DO

Youth between the ages of ten and eighteen, temporarily living in shelters, foster homes, group homes, detention centers and orphanages. Many have been abused and neglected and do not have a father present in their lives.



- Dare to Dream, builds Christian discipleship teams who share the Gospel in a Texas Youth Commission facility 15 times a year
- We also share the Gospel in Dallas County Juvenile Justice facilities
- Youth from a Juvenile Justice facility and a staff member are invited to monthly Full Gospel Businessmen's luncheons to hear a Gospel message and testimony. Youth get to build relationships and interact directly with the speaker and businessmen.

- We Conduct DreamMaker sessions with individuals to help them find their vision and purpose.
- We Pray with parents, single dads & moms, and youth who call DTD office for comfort and guidance for dealing with difficult and sometimes tragic situation
- We take prayer requests from youth in the facilities where we minister.

- Dare to Dream posts positive messages of encouragement on Facebook and other social media.
